<p>What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit?</p> <p>One of the Town Council's aims is to ensure that Corsham is a safe place to live and work. Like many other market towns, Corsham has experienced an increase in anti-social behaviour and criminal damage in recent years. A mobile CCTV system would assist the Police in crime detection and prevention and would help provide a sense of security for residents of the Parish. A mobile system could be deployed at short notice in locations where anti-social behaviour or vandalism is known to occur. The proposed mobile CCTV system is a potential benefit to all residents and visitors to Corsham Parish.</p> <p>The advantage of a mobile CCTV system over a fixed CCTV system is that its deployment is not restricted by the need for fixed cabling. This will enable the camera to be deployed in rural locations such as Neston and Gastard, in addition to locations in and around Corsham Town Centre.</p>
