

Scores on Doors

The scoring criteria for Scores on Doors is the sum of the scores for the following three elements:

Food hygiene and safety	how hygienically the food is handled, the cleanliness of the premises (0 to 25 points)
Structure	condition of the food rooms - structure, repair, lighting, ventilation, pest proofing. (0 to 25 points)
Confidence in Management	evidence of a food safety management system, whether there is a good history of complying with food law and acting on previous advice and the general attitude of the management. (0 to 30 points)
