

Scores of the Remaining Five Sites

1. Abberd Lane, Calne

This site is owned by NWDC and although within walking distance of Calne Town Centre is in a rural location accessed through residential development.

Score: 4

2. Site adjoining Oxford Road, Calne

The site is owned by NWDC and is allocated for employment purposes. While the site is a fair distance from the town centre and services, it has excellent road links and proximity to employment areas.

Score: 7

3. Land at Long Close & Hardens Mead, Chippenham

This is an area of public open space belonging to NWDC which is to a large extent overgrown with brambles and in parts is quite steeply sloping. Access is through a long established residential development and the site is in easy reach of local amenities, transport and schools.

Score: 4

5. Land at Stanley Lane, Chippenham

There are two possible sites on land owed by WCC with frontage to Stanley Lane. The better of the two sites would be almost adjoining the new secondary school and the other site would be somewhat further into the countryside. Nevertheless, both sites would have good highway access and be within reach of all amenities.

Score: 6

6. Land at Stoneover Lane, Wootton Bassett

This is a piece of land owned by WCC fronting on to Swindon Road. The site could possibly be accessed via Churchill Close although this may not be adequate. The location is very exposed having a long frontage to the main road.
