This project will benefit the 100 plus primary school children attending the school, as well as their parents, and all other persons wishing to walk in the village. This would be the only official crossing from east/west in the village. (Elsewhere children and adult cross as they can) This crossing will also help to slow south moving traffic at this point, just before it enters a traffic calming measure where the road narrows to a single carriageway with adjoining pavement only 2 feet wide.

The walking bus starting in the village soon, for children going to school, must use this part of the High Street, and requires an identified safe crossing point.

The Parish has spent some 2 years producing the Parish Plan and the Village Design Statement, both due to be published Feb/March 2007. The single most prominent cause for concern from the Parishioners has been the speed of the traffic passing through the village, with the lack of wide pavements and no identified crossing point to the school.

This project is being promoted by the Parish Council and Wiltshire County Council under the Walking to School Agenda. The Parish Council also hope that it will form a part of a series of traffic calming measures to make travel for pedestrians safer. It will be considered that this would be a continuing project for the Parish Council.

It is hoped that this scheme can be jointly funded by the Parish Council, Wiltshire County Council and North Wilts District Council.
