What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit?			
<p>Since Scouts and Guides reformed in Derry Hill in 2001, the Leaders have succeeded in attracting an increasing number of youngsters from the wider rural locale. There are currently 102 active Beavers, Cubs, Scouts, Brownies and Guides and 66 on the waiting lists. The new, larger hut would enable Leaders to increase participation and to store more equipment which would widen the scope and diversity of the learning opportunities that they offer. It would give purpose to unused agricultural land, safeguard the future of Scouts and Guides and serve other youth groups that spill over from the busy Village Hall. The new hut would extend access to those with physical disabilities and for parents of limited means, do away with the cost for school hall rental fees. The project would also promote youth involvement, reduce the likelihood of anti-social behaviour in an expanding rural community and provide benefits that would extend to future generations over the new hut's 25 year life span.</p> <p>Links to the Community Plan are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Offers alternative environments and routes to learning. - Takes learning to the rural community. - Is an event that focuses and promotes youth involvement. - Provides an amenity that supports the increasing population. - Makes use of agricultural land for leisure/recreational activity. - Encourages landowners to diversify the use of land. - Allays fears and reduces likelihood of anti-social behaviour.

3 – Additional information to support and strengthen your application e.g consultation, community involvement, energy efficiency measures				
<p>The existing hut, a war-time structure obtained by the MoD in 1979, is at the end of its useful life, parents and Leaders have justified concerns about safety, access, sanitation, hygiene and wasteful heating. There is an issue with nuisance to the neighbours and the lease on the site has expired. Cubs and Brownies rent Derry Hill School Hall which is undergoing modifications that will preclude its use by these groups in late 2007. Parents and Leaders are thus obliged to acquire a new hut to safeguard the future of Scouts and Guides and the resurgence of youth activity in Derry Hill where 50 new houses will be completed in Spring 2008. We have raised some £9,500.00 through self-help, obtained support from Calne (Without) Parish Council and in May 2007, planning permission was granted from North Wiltshire District Council. We have also secured a long-term tenancy agreement from Bowood Estate on whose ground, the new hut will be erected. The hut is energy efficient and is being used as the offices of a local building firm which has agreed to sell the hut to us and transport and erect it on its new site to which it is colour and material construction are aesthetically well suited. This is our first application for a major grant – we await responses to 12 other applications to small grant awarding bodies.</p>
