<p>The club's last wicket mower has ceased to be viable and we have been trying to cope with a modified surrounds mower this year. With the increase in both youth and senior matches on the square to approx. 80 matches annually the old mowers are now not mechanically fit for purpose. With the relocation (pending planning approval) to a new ground the amount of available cricket will increase even further. This grant would allow us to concentrate existing funds on the ongoing youth practice equipment improvements and coaching courses, which has seen expenditure of around £1,500 in the past 2 years alone. The benefit on the ground would be a dramatic improvement in the quality of prepared wickets to match the level that all our sides are now playing and take us into the, hoped-for, new ground with equipment to maintain grounds that can host cricket from under 9 to county senior matches. Wootton Bassett have a longstanding and successful youth section, a Club School Link partnership initiative with the Wootton Bassett schools being started this winter (ongoing meetings between Wootton Bassett Sports Association and Catrina Nicholas at Wootton Bassett School). We run teams in all age groups of the Wilts Youth Cricket League (under 11, 13 and 15) plus under 9 in the local tournaments run by the Wilts Cricket Board. Around 100 under members under 18 in 2008. There are four senior sides playing in the West of England Premier League and Wiltshire Cricket League, plus two midweek sides.</p>

The state of the machinery was highlighted in both and the following is the two main criteria that the WCB deem to be necessary for the club to meet its commitment to cricketing excellence. "...Aside from the clubhouse and facilities necessary at the new ground the item of most priority to the club is a new Wicket Shaver."
