There will be a larger fenced area for children and new equipment for under 5's. This is the first phase in a series of planned improvements for the site.</p> <p>It is expected that up to 400 children will benefit as well as their parents and carers.</p> <p>The new fencing will result in a quality environment for children and enable future expansion in play provision for a wide age range. The new equipment is aimed at under 5's as there is currently a lack of provision for that age group.</p>

### 3 – Additional information to support and strengthen your application e.g consultation, community involvement, energy efficiency measures

The recreation ground has been identified as having a great opportunity to improve the facilities for young people and adults. The large site is underused and lacks interesting and challenging features.

The Town Council held a public consultation meeting in Neston Village Hall in June 2007 where a list of priorities was identified. Around 40 people attended and a working group of six volunteers from the community was formed. The volunteer group has met on two occasions to agree how to move the project forward. A further public meeting is planned with the wider group and a budget has been agreed, along with a programme of improvements.

The Community Plan identifies the lack of provision of facilities for young people, especially in the villages. This grant application helps towards tackling this priority.

The equipment has been selected by the local community as it meets the local need. The play area currently lacks equipment for under fives and some of the older equipment is reaching the end of its useful life.

The Village Hall which is next to the Recreation Ground hosts a regular play group which uses the play area and open space. New equipment and a larger fencing area will be beneficial to that group.

The equipment and fencing will be robust and low maintenance in order to keep costs down and reduce the risk of vandalism. It is intended to reuse part of the old fencing as a barrier alongside a woodland path which is being created at the top of the site.
