Indoor meetings we have to charge a small fee which at the moment is £2 this is to pay for the hall etc. There is no charge for field trips. All of our workers are voluntary

Donations are received from groups we give talks to and anyone who asks us. We do not make a set fee but usually ask for expenses i.e. petrol and anything they can give. Some groups are not able to give us anything but we are still willing to speak to them.

We are a supporters Group and our remit is to support the WWT in any way we can using what skills we have. We are autonomous and help to raise funds for WWT when necessary.

The equipment would be stored with the Chair of the Chippenham & District Local Support Group and the insurance would be covered by Wiltshire Wildlife Trust.
