The whole Britain in Bloom project has generated strong community involvement across all elements of the population with young and old, youth groups working along side the elderly to encourage conservation and biodiversity and environmental protection of both wild life and fauna and flora. Experianced gardeners helping the inexperienced. The outcome has been an immense upsurge in civic pride throughout Cricklade The necessary approval from local authorities and land owners for all projects has been approved. The work to reestablish the Garden to a usable condition will take many hours and the vision for the project includes sufficient undercover areas to allow all weather use of the facilities in the form of a covered area for planting up baskets and potting on. A poly tunnel to protect plants and bring on cuttings and nursery stock. All of the labour to clear the land and lay paths and landscape fabric as well as building and laying hardstandings will be carried out by volunteers. No financial outlay will be used except for materials. The in Bloom Group and its supporters put in over 2000 hours in the last year to make Cricklade a better place, even at minimum wage rates this is worth over £10,500 to the community. Many members apart from their time give the use of specialist tools and personal financial support.
