There is resulting muddy pot-holes as well as damage to the edges of the road. County Highways are unable to fund repairs or install protection. By installing the kerbing and the placement of timber bollards we will keep the traffic on the road and eliminate damage to the Commons. The whole village (600+ villagers) plus children and parents attending the village primary school, many of whom live outside the village, will benefit from improved visual appearance and greater road safety.
