What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit?
Currently, the Corston children's play area is equipped with a range of fixed play equipment (swings, rockers etc). This equipment is now over 10 years old and has deteriorated to the extent that it is becoming unusable and does not meet current safety regulations. This includes the surface on which the equipment is installed. All the equipment in the Small Children's play area needs replacing and the swings in the older children's area need new seats and chains. The Parish Council carried out some work to the surface of the Small Children's play area this year costing £810.00. However, this was not adequate to satisfy current regulations and a further similar amount needs to be spent.

The need for the play area has increased over the past 10 years with the building of 2 small housing areas in the village.

This project will enable the small children, age 2 – 6, of the village of Corston to play in an area and on equipment that fully meets current safety regulations.

NWDC will not meet future running costs for projects. Please tell us how these will be met in future.
