3 - Additional information to support and strengthen your application e.g. consultation & community involvement

A Pilot study was carried out in consultation with National Trust Staff, volunteers, visitors and villagers in Lacock in July 2006. The feedback was positive and encouraging with the National Trust supportive of taking the project forward in 2007.

Wiltshire Community Services have given verbal support, as have the Arts Officers of Swindon Borough Council.

The archive of Lacock Abbey, which the group would need to access will only be available this next year until April 2007 when Wiltshire and Swindon Record office at Trowbridge will close prior to moving to Chippenham. An action plan listing aims and objectives include research of ideas to devise a programme of art activities. Previous community arts projects have been successfully carried out for Wiltshire County Council, Kennet District Council, for The Orders of St John Care Trust and The Marlborough Brandt Group.
