What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit?

The project will enable 3 new fully qualified coaches to work with young people at the cricket club alongside the existing coaches that the club has. This will enable the club to cope with the growing numbers of young people that are playing cricket at Purton CC in the junior section by providing an additional coaching group. This will ensure that coaching groups will have appropriate coach:player ratio's and have their own equipment to work with.

Purton CC has worked extremely hard in the last 12 months to ensure that it is providing safe, fun, effectively managed activities for young people. It has achieved the highest award from the County Sports Partnership for club accreditation which means it is recognised as having the appropriate child protection, child welfare, health and safety and administrative procedures and policies in place. The club has also worked with the local primary school and has developed a Club School Link which means there is communication between the club and the school and more young people are able to benefit through increased coaching sessions within the school and greater awareness of club activities out of school hours.

The club provides sport and physical activity in the form of cricket for young people aged between 7 and 15 years old and enables both skill development, social and personal development and team building skills to be developed in the young people who attend their sessions, as well as providing regular activity to encourage healthy lifestyles.

The club is prominent in the local community and works closely with the District Council's sports development activities as well as the County cricket board. The club serves all villages and communities throughout Area 2, including Purton, Braydon, Lydiard and Wootton Bassett, and contributes, through its work with young people in particular, to the Community Plan objectives of improving recreational and social facilities, encouraging health and well-being and indirectly assisting with community safety issues by providing positive activity for a large number of local young people.
