## 3 – Additional information to support and strengthen your application e.g consultation, community involvement, energy efficiency measures

The Club's involvement with the local community is well documented. Since forming in 1974, we have taught literally hundreds of youngsters to swim, some of whom have gone on to National standard. Very much a "Club for All", Corsham was the first Club in Wiltshire to gain the ASA's coveted Swim 21 accreditation and Sport England Clubmark award. These demonstrate to a National Panel excellence in child protection, health & safety, teaching profciency and excellent administration. Awarded on a four yearly cycle, Corsham will become the first club in South West England to re-accredit in January 2008. All of the teachers, coaches and poolside helpers are volunteers, and the Club is self supporting based on the income it generates from subscriptions. Any spare money is ploughed back directly into Club related activities, such as swim clinics, training courses and bursaries.

Keeping the Club's coaches and teachers fully up to date with developments in the ASA's National Teaching Plan is proving to be expensive. The cost of even the lowest teaching qualification has increased steadily over the past few years and is now set to raise even further, as much of the money previously available through bodies such as Sport England, is now being channelled to Schools of Excellence in preparation for the 2012 Olympics. In order to supplement the continuing shortage of qualified teachers in North Wilts, Corsham ASC aims to increase the number of its teachers by at least two per year. With the assistance of a Community Grant, we would be able to supplement the cost of courses, thus making them more accessible
