Fairtrade is all about engaging the community in sustainable development, helping promote sustainable global trade and increased social justice to the poorer parts of the globe. The Fairtrade events allow attendees to consult Fairtrade promoters and suppliers such as the Cooperative Society and Oxfam, as well as local community Traidcraft traders. Fairtrade is also environmentally friendly and promotes sustainable use of resources. The Coop and others supply and promote the use of reusable cotton bags, as a substitute for plastic bags. Fairtrade products do not compete with local temperate produce and are transported by sea, one of the most sustainable forms of transport, helping limit greenhouse gas emissions and reduce global warming. CAVE is working in Partnership with Chippenham Town Council who have resolved to make Chippenham a Fairtrade Town. CAVE will also be supporting local schools who wish to become Fairtrade Schools.

CAVE will be working in partnership with Chippenham & District Wiltshire Wildlife Trust Group, Whale & Dolphin Society, Chippenham Civic Society, village shops & post offices, schools and churches, and other interested parties to deliver the plastic bag campaign.
