

BEECH GROVE COMMUNITY GARDEN

Site 1	Existing use as a wild life garden. Meets residents expectations.
Site 2	Childrens play area, and green, used for football etc. Two routes from existing site, both outside the 300 metres.
Site 3	Bradley Rd site, outside the 300 metres. Land not on the
Site 2	ROUTE FROM CENTRE OF SITE 1
Route 1	Right into Beech Grove, straight on, left into alleyway, into hard surfaced play area. Straight on to proposed site. 340 metres.
Route 2	ROUTE FROM CENTRE OF SITE 2
	Garage entrance, left into Laburnum Grove, right into Beech Grove, straight onto existing garden. 320 metres.
Site 3	ROUTE FROM CENTRE OF SITE 1
Route 1	Cedar Grove, left into alleyway to Laurel Grove, right into Maple Grove, left to College Rd, left Cavell Court, entrance to proposed site 3. 511 metres.
Route 2	Cedar Grove, left College Rd, left Bradley Rd, left into proposed site 3. 590 metres.

All proposed new sites are outside of the 300 metre limit.

Site 2 was always a play area, since the estate was built in the early 60,s.It was refurbished because of the Homezone.

Site 3 is on a different estate to our own.

By drawing a circle on a map, it does not take into consideration the moving of garden equipment (wheelbarrows, spades etc) to either of the proposed sites.
