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1. Introduction

1.1 The purpose of this report is to inform the Committee of the Sub Committees, Working Groups and Outside Bodies for which appointments are required.

3. Background Information

- 3.1 All Standing Committees of the Council are required to appoint an Urgent Matters Sub Committee. The Constitution requires that the Membership of each Urgent Matters Sub Committee shall comprise the Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Committee, together with one other Member of the Committee and a further three Members of the Standing Committee to act as Deputies.
- 3.2 The Personnel, Licensing & Administration Committee is also required to provide for consultations with employees through the Local Joint Consultative Committee and for employee representation through the Joint Safety Committee.
- 3.3 The Committee has in previous years also appointed a Licensing & Registration Sub Committee and the Members Development Group.
- 3.4 Details of the suggested numbers of seats for each of the Sub Committees and the Working Group required for this year are set out at the Appendix to this report.
- 3.5 In previous years the Committee has nominated a representative to attend South West Provincial Council meetings on its behalf. The first full Provincial Council Meeting for 2007/08 will be held on 29th June 2007 and so the Committee is requested to appoint a Member to represent the Council.
- 3.6 The Urgent Matters Sub Committee and the Licensing and Registration Sub Committee will need to be politically balanced by law. The Local Joint Consultative Committee, the Joint Safety Committee and the Members Development Group will be politically balanced by convention.
