- 3.3 The Committee has in previous years also appointed a Licensing & Registration Sub Committee and the Members Development Group.
- 3.4 Details of the suggested numbers of seats for each of the Sub Committees and the Working Group required for this year are set out at the Appendix to this report.
- 3.5 The Urgent Matters Sub Committee and the Licensing and Registration Sub Committee will need to be politically balanced by law. The Local Joint Consultative Committee, the Joint Safety Committee and the Members Development Group will be politically balanced by convention.
