The toilets in the village hall were put in 27 years ago with the ladies receiving some modification for disabled persons use. The male toilet has no disabled facilities, inadequate hand washing facilities and neither make the best use of the available space.						
The village hall undertook a Disability Discrimination Act audit some time ago and this work will help to bring the building into line with the requirements identified there in and move it further forwards towards being DDA compliant.						
All groups will benefit from the new facility. We have a weekly over 60 lunch club, toddler group who need a nappy changing facility. Many evening functions as stated previously. The groups who use the hall weekly are tap, toddlers, oldbury club, cubs, beavers, scouts, fit club, yoga, monthly WI, gardening and parish council. There are Christmas parties, plays and pantomime and flower shows. The facilities need to be updated to make them fully accessible to all.
