We will invite partner organisations such as the Energy Saving Trust to provide free, impartial advice on saving energy in the home and grants that are available. Such advice is valuable at this time of year, especially for those who are vulnerable to the financial and health risks of fuel poverty. We will work with and support local community groups whilst delivering the project and promoting volunteering of all sorts to the wider public; including getting active with conservation volunteering. Volunteering opportunities encourage people to join together no matter their age, gender, ethnicity or background, to help the environment, whilst having fun and promoting physical and mental wellbeing. All this will be displayed with a festive, fun theme with attractions such as activities, samples, workshops, speakers and give always to entice visitors from all backgrounds to join the fun. The GLR is targeted at the full age range with help for young people, mothers with babies, families, older people, unemployed and financially disadvantaged individuals and any ethnic and religious groups.
