Arts Together is for physically or socially isolated older people. Most are frail or have disabilities. We provide a huge variety of professional arts activities designed to offer physical stimulation and mental challenge in a safe and friendly environment as well as a locally sourced, fresh lunch. Members increase their manual dexterity and mental agility and become noticeably more confident whilst making friends and having a lot of fun. The sessions also provide respite for the carers of some members. Our group meets weekly and has 12 members, male and female, aged between 65 and 99. They are physically or mentally frail and require high levels of support. The project also provides work for Wiltshire artists and rewarding volunteering opportunities for local people. Our 3 volunteers derive great satisfaction from working with our lively group as do our carefully selected artists. Volunteers and artists benefit from regular training and support. The Phoenix Project will contribute to the sustainability of Arts Together by increasing local support, reducing grant dependence and ensuring that all potential members know about us. It will increase opportunities for local people to gain skills, experience and training and open new avenues for local businesses to engage with an underestimated section of our community. In our experience, involvement with Arts Together increases understanding and enjoyment of the arts, and of older people, by even the most sceptical

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More than half our costs are from contributions in kind such as volunteer time, food, design, venues and some transport. We work closely with the DACS team (transport) Sarsen Housing (venue) and with Ridgeway Care (professional carers). The DACS team refer many of their clients to our group and are regular visitors. We are a member of the Wiltshire Social Inclusion Partnership and take part in the Voluntary Sector Assembly. The group are the primary beneficiaries as the Phoenix project will help ensure the survival of Arts Together and the benefits they gain. We will know if the project has worked by the number of volunteers we recruit, train and retain; the number of local businesses and organisations they contact and the number who become involved in Arts Together; and in the number of new members who join Arts Together. Due to the age of our members, there is a continual need for new member recruitment. We have an established programme to consult with and involve group members and volunteers, who are also trustees. We will establish through this whether members are benefiting and in what way, and what they want for the future. We realise that in order to survive and reach the many isolated older people, we must raise our profile locally and increase support. To do this we will recruit up to 5 volunteers with local knowledge and contacts to work as our Marlborough team. The project will be coordinated by our Manager who will recruit, train and support the team.
