Assistance donations & help have been offered by the Church & WI

The entire village including existing & new groups anticipated to take part in the creation of features in the play area (with possible artistic assistance for community projects offered by Wiltshire Arts) stand to benefit .The village has a primary & pre school playgroup & Sunday School The play area was much used by local children & enjoyed by accompanying adults.& those visiting the recreation ground
