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Back in 1999/2000 the Oare Village Hall Committee embarked on this project. (Oare with some other hamlets nestles under the Marlborough downs, between Marlborough and Pewsey). The idea was to produce a pictorial record, a book, of those residents/dwellings within a defined area of Oare with Rainscombe, Huish, Draycot Fitzpaine and Sunnyhill Lane with Highleaze. Having experienced a few ups and downs, not least of which has been time, we are at artwork! The finished publication will be around A3 (420 x 297 mm ish) portrait, 104 pages and in colour. A double page spread of a group photo (circa 188 people) with a dps keyed legend; thirteen pages of a millennial survey with old images of the area; two pages of old Huish farming images; one page each of two quite different millennial projects and 72 pages (144 pictures and descriptions) of people and places, businesses and groups. An historical, educational, architectural and heritable record of the people and places within this beautiful area of Wiltshire. Printing will be a paperback and leather option. Apart from the legal deposit, we will donate further copies locally - the two churches, local schools, libraries, heritage centre, etc – in all about twenty.
