Response from Laverstock & Ford Parish Council

Re: Laverstock to City Centre Cycle Facilities

The proposals were discussed by the Parish Council at a meeting last night. There was a lively debate and, whilst the scheme was not supported unanimously by the Council, we have voted to proceed as described, with several caveats:

- As the scheme only involves the application of paint, we would wish to see a one year trial to assess its success. Should it not prove successful (and we really do want it to be!) then the situation that pertains now should be re-instated.
- We wish to see the creation of a no park zone during school hours within the school locality.
- We would wish to have clarified the position regarding parking within the defined cycle lane, particularly in school times.
- We wish to see the scheme extended along Church Rd from St Joseph's School to St Thomas's roundabout.
- We also wish to see the scheme extended up Laverstock Rd to Godolphin School
