What is the community benefit of your project? There are 30 young people of school age living in Yatesbury. At present there are no recreational facilities available for them. In the first quarter of 2009 a Youth Club is being set up to operate on a weekly basis providing the youth people the opportunity to use a range of equipment offered to the group; these items include table tennis, pool, football and cricket. These will be used in the Village Hall or the field adjacent to it. However, we cannot make use of these offers because we have no space in which to store the equipment. The project will provide this space and our young people will have access to the recreational facilities they so badly need.

The Village already posses some important pieces of equipment. Most significant are a small marquee and a set of display boards. At present there is no satisfactory storage place for these. They are kept in open barns and the corners of peoples' garages.

As a result they are not easily available and not used as often as they might be. The entire community would benefit if they could be stored in one place, close to where they would be used; i.e. next to the Village Hall. Plans are being developed to acquire a barbeque for community use. This too will be possible only if suitable storage space was available.

The Yatesbury community is desperately short of space to take care of the equipment needed to promote and support community activities. While the immediate need is for somewhere to put recreational equipment for our young people, in the longer term the entire population of the village will benefit.
