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A recent survey 'The people's Choice' 2007 showed in Calne people were poor at volunteering and just as poor at participating in leisure activities, when compared to other areas. As a cricket club we have a proven record at encouraging volunteers. We strongly believe that an artificial wicket will encourage more people to volunteer and play sport. The club work closely with the local schools and ECB, who will grant £3,000 of the cost (see enclosed letters).

An artificial wicket will allow the continued growth of cricket in the town. We are a growing club and in need of more space for a 3<sup>rd</sup> side which is one thing this project will provide; without it we will probably lose young players to other clubs, this causing further decline in sport and leisure activities in the town.
