Facilities that will greatly benefit the youth of the village but will be available for use by people of all ages. Currently ad-hoc sports take place on grass adjacent to roads and on roads themselves. An under 5's group has expressed interest in the long term use of the building with part of the land as an allocated under 5's play area and the village school will use the area on a more general basis. A youth shelter will double as a seating area for parent/gardian use while young children use the cycle path or the general amenity land. The car park facility will not only serve the amenity land but will also provide off road parking for the village school and new under 5s centre,plus a drop off / pick up point for both of these buildings. Currently there is dangerous parking on the road outside the school. The perimeter cycle path is intended for young children to learn and develop their cycling without the dangers of normal road traffic. There is potential for the whole of the village community to benefit in one way or another from these facilities.
