Giving vulnerable female teenagers under 19 years of age,Protection against having to sleep rough in any circumstances; preventing distress and disorder to themselves and the community. The project will provide supportive training in budgeting, housekeeping, preparing of and cooking nutricious meals. Structured courses on personal issues like hygiene and sexual matters will be on offer as will beneficial exercise such as Pilates and yoga. Accessing help from other Organisations will be encouraged and because young people are not to hot on keeping appointments we shall arrange with other Organisations to make the initial contact/visit at the project.
