**HT-007-12 - VICARAGE CLOSE, MARLBOROUGH: PARKING
CONTROLS OBJECTIONS TO PROPOSALS**

Purpose of Report

To:

- (i) Consider objections to the advertised proposals for parking controls at Vicarage Close in Marlborough.
- (ii) Recommend the making of the Order with minor amendments.

Consultation

The Town Council was consulted prior to the advertisement process and supported the proposals. The recommendations have been discussed with the Local Members.

As a result of the public advertisement 25 letters of objection/support have been received. These are listed in **Appendix 2** together with a summary of their comments. Officer comments on the points raised are set out in **Appendix 3**.

Options Considered

To:

- (i) Implement the proposals as advertised.
- (ii) Not implement the proposals.
- (iii) Implement the proposals with amendments.

Reason for Decision

The comments set out in **Appendix 3** on the various objections received indicate that it is considered appropriate to introduce the scheme with the minor amendments detailed in **Appendix 4**.

DECISION MADE

I approve that:

- (i) The restrictions be implemented as advertised, subject to the relaxations detailed in **Appendix 4**.
- (ii) The objectors be informed accordingly.
