# Commons Act 2006 - Sections 15(1) and (2) - Application to Register Land as Town or Village Green

Southwick Court Fields: Southwick and North Bradley - Application No. 2020/02TVG (Pages 15 - 92)

To:

Consider the Advisory Report, dated 9 February 2024, submitted by Mr William Webster of 3 Paper Buildings, appointed by Wiltshire Council as the Commons Registration Authority (CRA), to act as an independent Inspector to:

- Preside over a non-statutory public inquiry, held on 21-22
  November 2023 at St Johns Parish Centre, Studley Green,
  Trowbridge, to consider an application made under Sections
  15(1) and (2) of the Commons Act 2006, to register land at
  Southwick Court Fields, in the parishes of Southwick and North
  Bradley, as a Town or Village Green (TVG), and
- Produce an advisory report to include a recommendation to the CRA to assist in its determination of the application.
