We would have to take money from our development fund, which is being built up to provide additional facilities at the Recreation Ground over the next few years. It is planned that these will include a multi use games area, various improvements to the changing rooms and an additional room alongside the existing changing rooms that would be used for social functions connected with sport being played at the Ground. The provision of these facilities would be delayed.						
How will you know whether your project	t has made a difference	e in the community?				
Ever since the Ground was opened (in 1997) football has rarely been played from November to February due to very muddy pitches. Regular use of the mower will improve the condition of the grass playing surfaces. This should allow sports, especially football, to be played for more of the winter months. We should also be able to offer the use of the Ground to more teams, especially youth teams on an additional pitch, at least for occasional matches.
