Please tell us about the project /activity you want to organise/deliver and why? <i>Important: This section is limited to 900 characters only (inclusive of spaces).</i>	<p>The aim of this project is for 7 schools within the Tidworth Community Area to achieve at least Bronze level on the Wiltshire Healthy Schools programme. Data presented to the Area Board in November 2015 by Public Health highlighted that 25.5% of children in Reception Year are obese/ overweight compared to the Wiltshire average of 21.2% and Year 6, 33% are obese/ overweight compared to the Wiltshire average of 29.6%. The most efficient and effective way of tackling this issue is through working with the schools directly.</p> <p>The Healthy Schools programme actively promotes learning and healthy lifestyle choices for children and supports the schools capacity to deliver effective and sustainable interventions for all children</p> <p><i>The ambition of this project is that money is provided upfront to deliver a long term sustainable</i></p>
