FUND OVERVIEW

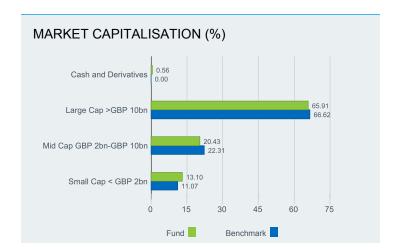
