Artwork of 2 winners from each school will be put on display in each partner retailers store, giving visibilty to the wider Marlborough Community. There will be 2 overall winners, sponsored by The Chamber of Commerce. Prize giving will be on the evening of April 1 <sup>st</sup> 2011.
