Please accept this letter as an indication of in-principle support from Wiltshire Council's Sports Development team for the above-named project.

A key target for Wiltshire Council is to increase levels of sports participation and physical activity amongst residents and as a vehicle to enhance their physical, mental, and social wellbeing.
