This document contains a summary of the 2011-2012 action plan for Malmesbury and the Villages Community Area Partnership (MVCAP). The intention is that by collecting all the planned activities, costs, and targets together in one document an overall understanding of the Partnership's aims for the next year can be easily reached.

There are a lot of projects contained in this plan. While MVCAP aim to complete them all, it is understood that this may not be possible with the current resources available - particularly the number of active volunteers at the time of writing (March 2011). The priorities for the next year are MVCAP's ongoing activities, the Community Hub project, and the IZWE project. The latter two will however demand significant resources and so are heavily dependent on the availability and interest of volunteers.

The Malmesbury - Tetbury bus service project is a direct result of our public consultation meeting held in September 2010. The first step for this initiative is to explore the options and economics for increasing the bus service between these two hubs. While this has the potential to develop into a major project, it seems likely that the current financial situation and realities of funding services may make it difficult to achieve any improvement in the near future. MVCAP however feel that it is important to have at least explored the options.

Some other projects, such as continuation of work on Reduced Street-lighting or the Community Link pilot scheme, may require the input of only one or two members and are building on past experiences. In this light these should hopefully be achievable. The Community Link scheme however does have the potential to grow if the pilot proves successful.

The events listed are dependant upon a number of factors. The "freshers fair" event is pretty clearly defined, but the details of the Housing/planning event and the Environment event are still being worked out and are to a certain extent reliant upon the enthusiasm and needs of partner organisations.

Terms used

Theme - A subject area or issues that one or more projects are intended to address.

Project - An individual or related group of schemes being run by MVCAP

Impact - If the project is successful what will have been achieved

SMART Targets - How the success of a project can be measured. SMART stands for Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Realistic, and Time-based.

Costs - Resource requirements for project, both monetary and other costs
