the college.Occassionally items are made such as jellies and chutneys which can be sold iin the college shop.						
There is capacity to expand this enterprise - the catering kitchen is under used in the afternoons, but it is not well						
enough equiped to produce a wider range of products. In the longer term the college would like to extend the current						
shop premises to include a small café. The café would be staffed by students and serve the local community. The						
purchase of the catering equipment requested would allow students to learn an increased range of catering skills and students who work in the college shop to learn how to store a wider range of produce, learn more about sell by						
and use by dates. The shop would attract more customers. The course aims to teach students vocational and work						
based skills and provide work experie						

Currently the college has 28 residential students and 4 day students all with learning disabilities (LLD). 8 LDD students from Wiltshire College attend Fairfield for one day a week to learn practical work skills. Students range from 16 - 25 years of age and 33% female and 66% male. 6% of college students are from BME backgrounds. The college offers work experience placements to young people from local schools and colleges, some who have LDD

and some who want to work with LDD
