Older People Development Strategy

- Aim – To develop modern and fit for purpose facilities to meet current and future needs and expectations of the people of Wiltshire
- Focuses on nursing care, specialist dementia care and extra care housing provision
- Reduction in standard residential care
- 10 year programme – flexible
- Delivered through partnership working

Developments in Warminster

- 80 bed nursing home with OSJCT
- Replace Woodmead care home
- Timescale

- Outcome of sheltered housing review

Conclusions

- Substantial improvement of older people's accommodation in Wiltshire
- 715 units of extra care, 338 specialist dementia care placements and 539 additional nursing beds
- Future management of demand and adult social care budgets
