This forms a dense carpet in the shallow eastern end of the pond which stretches across the pond and threatens to reduce and shade the deeper water in the western end. The Project is targeted towards the restoration of this major pond on Poulshot Green which is accessible to the local and wider community. The pond has a breeding population of rare and protected Great Crested Newts.
