This is always more apparent during the junior training sessions as they are unable to disguise their disappointment. We already have the basics in place which were great when we were a less popular club but we would prefer to be able to meet the demand of our members and the local community by making these much needed improvements. The problem is technical one, in that when we installed the net bases some years ago we were concerned about them encroaching on the main playing area - we have since discovered that the surfaces we have installed are about 2.5m shorter than ideal meaning that for certain types of practice they cannot be used. We have a very small ground but as a club committee we have decided that the size of the ground in one small area needs to be sacrificed to make full and proper use of the nets by extending them 2.5 - 3m

It gives people a chance to keep fit and socialise, especially for children who mix with other children they probably do not go to school with. We attract players from the local villages and towns which saves them having to travel miles to reach a club of similar set up. The success of the club over the last few years such as having achieved ECB clubmark accreditation and 2 successive promotions has meant that the club has attracted more players and so we are trying to make improvements to our facilities so that we can continue the good work that has gone on before, whilst ensuring the safety of our members whilst using them. If we can increase the length of the surface it will make the nets safer for users of all ages and abilities, and will therefore increase the number of participants
