

Area Board Project/Councillor Initiative

1. What is the project?

Calne Area Board is running a project called 'Calne Voices', which aims to engage and promote the views, experiences and issues of people with learning difficulties and are on the autism spectrum.

Councillor Christine Crisp represents the Board on the steering group of Calne Voices alongside partners from Wiltshire People First, The Mill Race Activity Centre (Marden House), Keyring Wiltshire Commissioning team for people with disabilities and Springfields School.

This group is planning an arts project that will comprise 3 sessions with a professional art facilitator who will help a group of up to 30 local people with learning difficulties and autism express their views, experiences and issues through the medium of art. The finished art works will also serve as a resource to be shared with local schools, libraries, community groups and the area board to promote discussion, understanding and the reduction of misconceived perceptions of people with learning difficulties and autism.

2. Where is the project taking place?

The project will take place in Calne and will be open to people with learning difficulties from Calne and the surrounding area.

3. When will the project take place?

2 sessions will be held in January 2012 and a 3rd in February 2012.

Wiltshire Council has recognised the need to engage with 'seldom heard' groups of people and has developed a county wide project called 'Wiltshire Voices'.
