The increasing amount of cricket being coached and played has led to BCC seeking a second ground to play on, particularly for the Youth sides. During 2011 a ground-share with Cherhill CC was arranged, however this involves a round-trip of over 10 miles. BCC has recently been lucky enough to secure a new ground at a peppercorn rent in the village of Beanacre. Turning the field into a playing surface has however been a long and expensive operation, until now funded entirely by the club's own fund-raising activities. We are now at the stage where we need to buy a roller to prepare the wicket.

The Club has been expanding in recent years and now fields 3 adult teams in the WIItshire Cricket League and 3 youth teams in the Bath & District League. The increasing amount of cricket being coached and played led to the Club seeking a second ground to play regular games on, particularly for the Youth sides. There are no alternative facilities in Melksham: the only other pitch is already fully booked and will be closed with the development of the Community Campus, and to use the Melksham Oak facilities would cost in excess of £10 per player per game. During the 2010/11 season a ground-share with Cherhill CC was arranged, however this involved a trip of over 10 miles each way for "home" matches.
