

## Marlborough Area Board – Fund towards celebrations for the Jubilee / Olympics

### 1. What is the event / initiative?

A weekend of village events including – Open Gardens, children’s activities, jubilee scarecrows, a treasure hunt and culminating in a barbecue for the whole village before lighting a beacon and a firework display.

### 2. Where is the event / initiative taking place?

Throughout Ogbourne St George Village with the barbecue to be held at the Village School.

### 3. When will the event / initiative take place?

Sunday and Monday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>.

### 4. What are the Community benefits / links to Community Plan?

The Parish Plan which is in preparation has highlighted a lack of community spirit within the village. It is anticipated that these events will go a long way to addressing this.

### 5. What is the desired outcome of this event / initiative?

To bring the village together in celebration of the Jubilee and to encourage community cohesion. Our initial meeting and consultation about proposed events has been met with great enthusiasm so we feel we are moving towards achieving our objective.

### 6. Who will Project Manage this event / initiative?

The Parish Council and a committee of village volunteers.

### 7. Costs/quotes/ match funding?

Meat for the barbecue – 150 portions x £3.00 = £450. Jubilee mementos for village children (0-16). 100 x £1.50 = £150. Prizes - £30. Total £630. Fireworks will be donated. A donation from the Parish Council is anticipated and a fund raising event will be held ahead of the Jubilee weekend. Villagers will contribute in kind by donating salads and puddings to the barbecue and cakes for the Open Garden teas. **Grant requested £500.**
