The Police Authority is currently writing the Policing Plan for 2012/2013. This is the last plan that the Authority will write in advance of the election of a Police and Crime Commissioner for Wiltshire and Swindon in November. We undertake consultation in as many places as possible, (in addition to our public survey, meeting with MP's, Councillors and the Youth parliament), and feedback from Area Boards is key to our understanding of the issues that effect your community. The table below provides statistical information on current performance compared to the previous 12-months. There has been a very small increase of 12 reported crimes. The significant reduction in Dwelling Burglaries, 32 less victims, is the best area of performance.
