Melksham was one of the highest areas. Splitz has been working with parents and families who have experienced separation, divorce and domestic abuse since 1989. One of their major concerns is the effect of the abuse on their children: their performance at school is affected and their relationships at home are damaged. There is also evidence that many children who have witnessed domestic abuse become victims or perpetrators of abuse themselves in adult life. Through our project, the children's behaviour at school and at home will improve; they will become more engaged in their studies and develop healthier relationships in the future.
