Wiltshire Council is seeking funding for the hire and associates costs for the jousting tent, and it is only if this grant is not successful that area board funding will need to be used.

Pewsey Area Board does however need to produce display material and the costs are not yet known. However as the event is before the next area board meeting there is a need for area board approval at the March meeting.

The benefits of being involved in the event are great; this is an ideal opportunity to showcase the community and its rich history and heritage. A working group has been established and ideas currently include Wilton Windmill, Crofton Pumping Station, Wiltshire Horned Sheep, Pewsey Heritage Centre, Pewsey Carnival and Marshalls Bakery. Young people from the Youth Centre are going to be taking photographs. It is envisaged that a timeline will be produced as a banner going round the inside of the tent. Parish Councils are being asked to send in details of dates, and 2 monuments or significant natural or manmade features of the area that tourists to the area may want to visit so that these can be produced on a map.

Display materials for the Queen's Jubilee Event. Grafton have offered to host the banner at the Coronation Hall.
