1. What is the project?

Diamond Jubilee Event

2012 is the year that the Queen celebrates 60 years on the throne. To celebrate the Diamond Jubilee Salisbury Cathedral Close will be hosting an event which will be attended by people from across the county.

Each of the 18 Community Areas in Wiltshire have been asked to book a "Jousting Tent" and are invited to use them to showcase what is best about their area. Devizes has accepted the invitation and David Dawson, Director of Wiltshire Heritage Museum has kindly agreed to take the lead on the project.

The event is will run between 10am and 5.30pm on Tuesday 1 May. This is around the time that the Queen herself will be visiting Salisbury and it is likely that she will attend.

In order to finance this project, the request is for £3,500 to be ring fenced for any associated payments
