Some 10 years ago, the club started a junior section which has proved to be a significant development in ensuring that village cricket remains strong in Ashton Keynes, The club accommodates players from the age of 6 upwards. Besides the senior teams, the club has competitive teams at U9, U11, U13 and U15. In 2011 we expect to have an U17 team. As the number of teams has risen and the ability of the players has improved, there is pressure to prepare more and more tracks (pitches) within the confines of "the square". The quality of the track should be such that it makes playing a pleasurable experience. To this end the club invests a significant proportion of its income in insuring that the square has an annual overhaul. The day to day maintenance is manual which means that we cannot dedicate enough time to the eradication of weeds and other pests which conspire to make parts of the square less than suitable for play.
