I am pleased to report the community area of Malmesbury has in general been fairly quiet since the last meeting. Of note though are a couple of rural dwelling burglaries that occurred a couple of weeks ago. Both burglaries occurred while the occupants were out and in one, their car was also stolen. Enquires are ongoing and there may be a possible link to other similar offences in neighbouring Chippenham where out of force criminals are suspected.

Some of you may have noticed that Malmesbury Police now have a Facebook page. We have had some impressive hits on the site with over 400 views on some articles. We are keen to reach as many people in the Community and

feel this is a valuable tool to enable us to do this, alongside our other methods such as newsletters, consultations etc.
