(Limited to a 1000 characters) -Cricket is the only major team sport now played in Bedwyn and the surrounding area. - Despite being a village club, GBCC competes in Wiltshire Premier Division 1st and 2nd XI leagues composed mainly of town teams. - In 2012 GBCC came third in the 1st XI League and 2nd in the 2nd XI League, having at one stage led both tables, and with only a few points separating the top teams. - GBCC also competes in Savernake leagues and other competitions; having become the Wiltshire indoor winner, it represented Wiltshire in the National Indoor Championship in 2012. - Unlike some other clubs who despite their bigger catchment populations import good players from elsewhere, GBCC players are all local people - GBCC has never been a wealthy club, and has relied mainly on its own resources. Th Club has extended the playing area in 2008 and are looking to raise £170,000 to build a new pavillion. (Plans approved 2011) The Club has set a side £40,000 of its own funds towards this.
